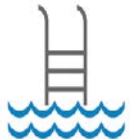

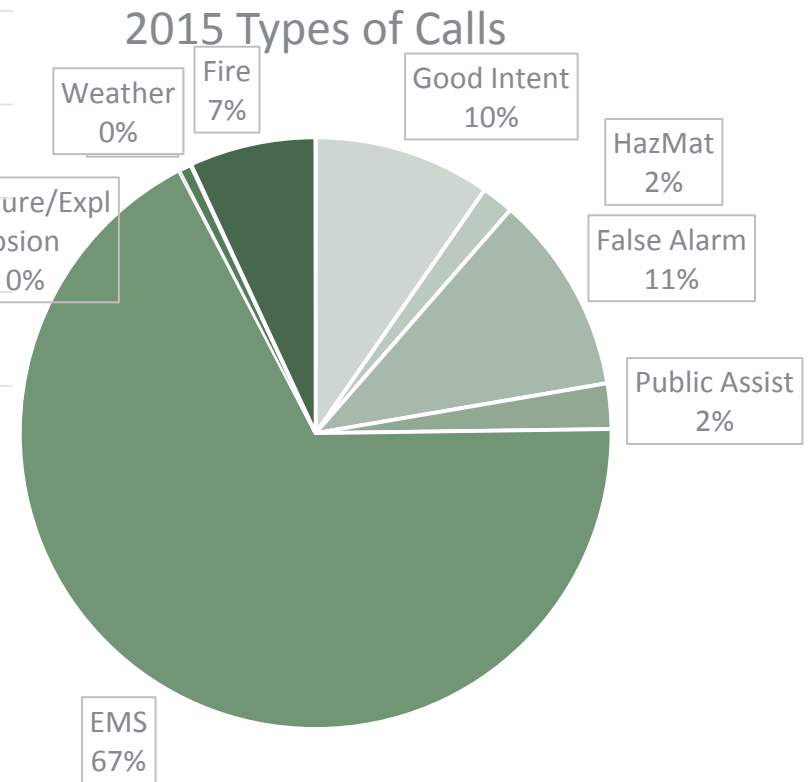
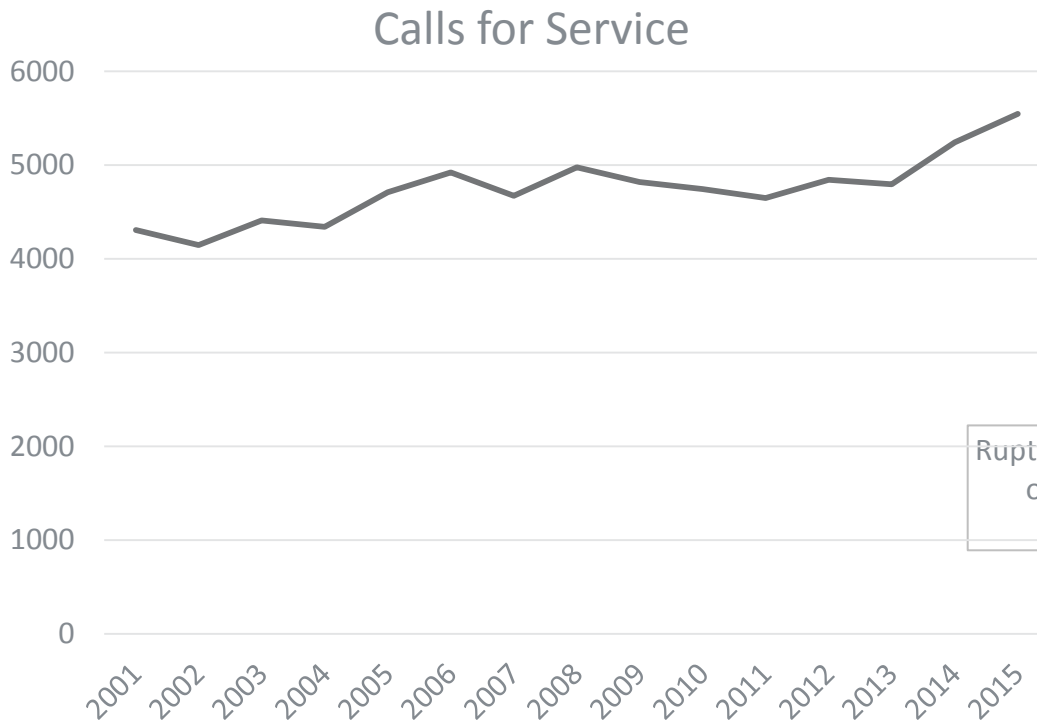


River is both a barrier and rescue location



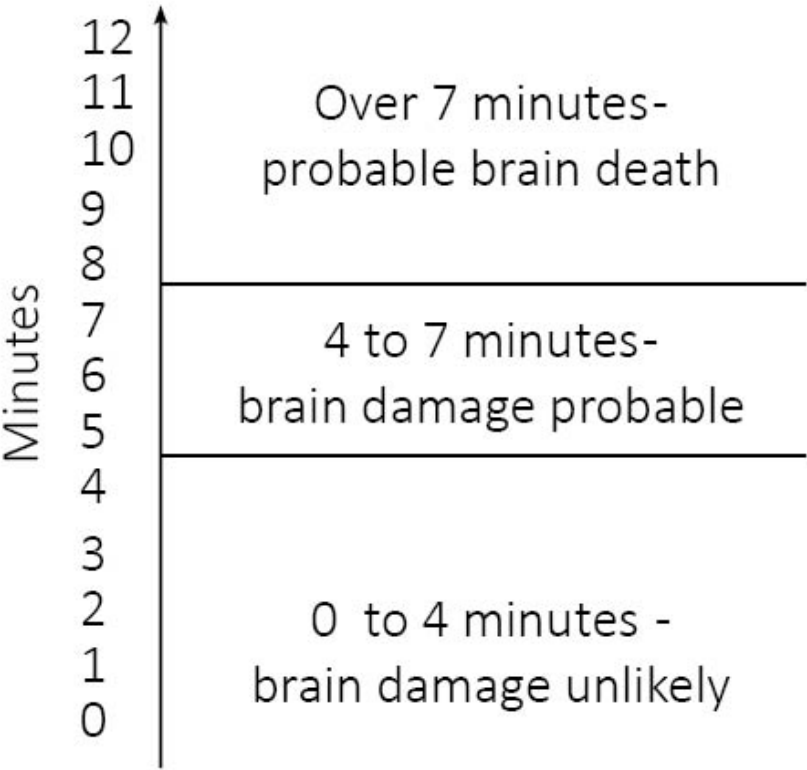
Freeways both barriers and response location

Types and number of calls

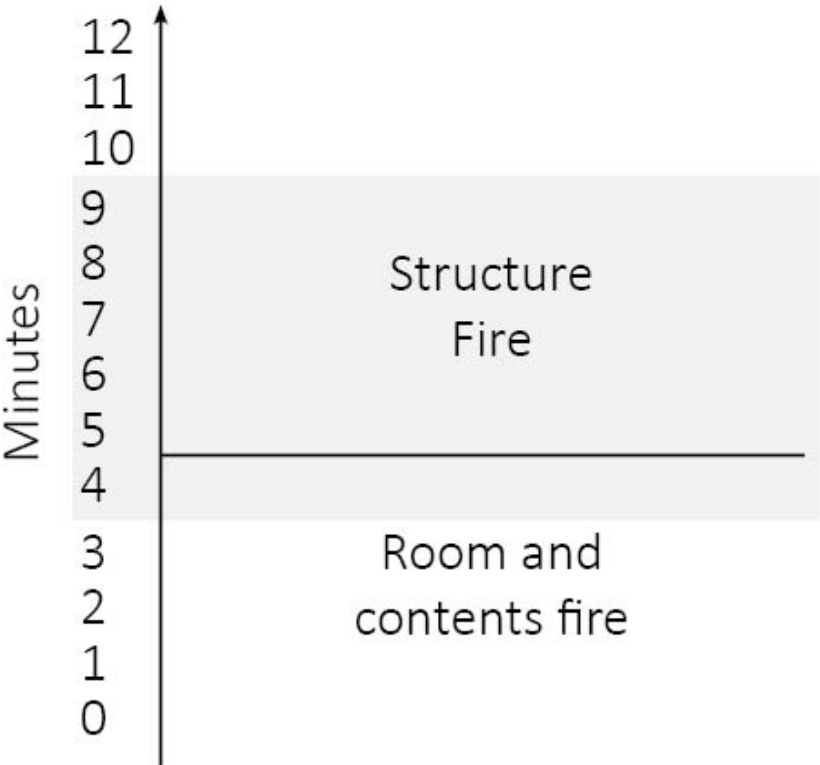




CPR Timeline



Fire Timeline





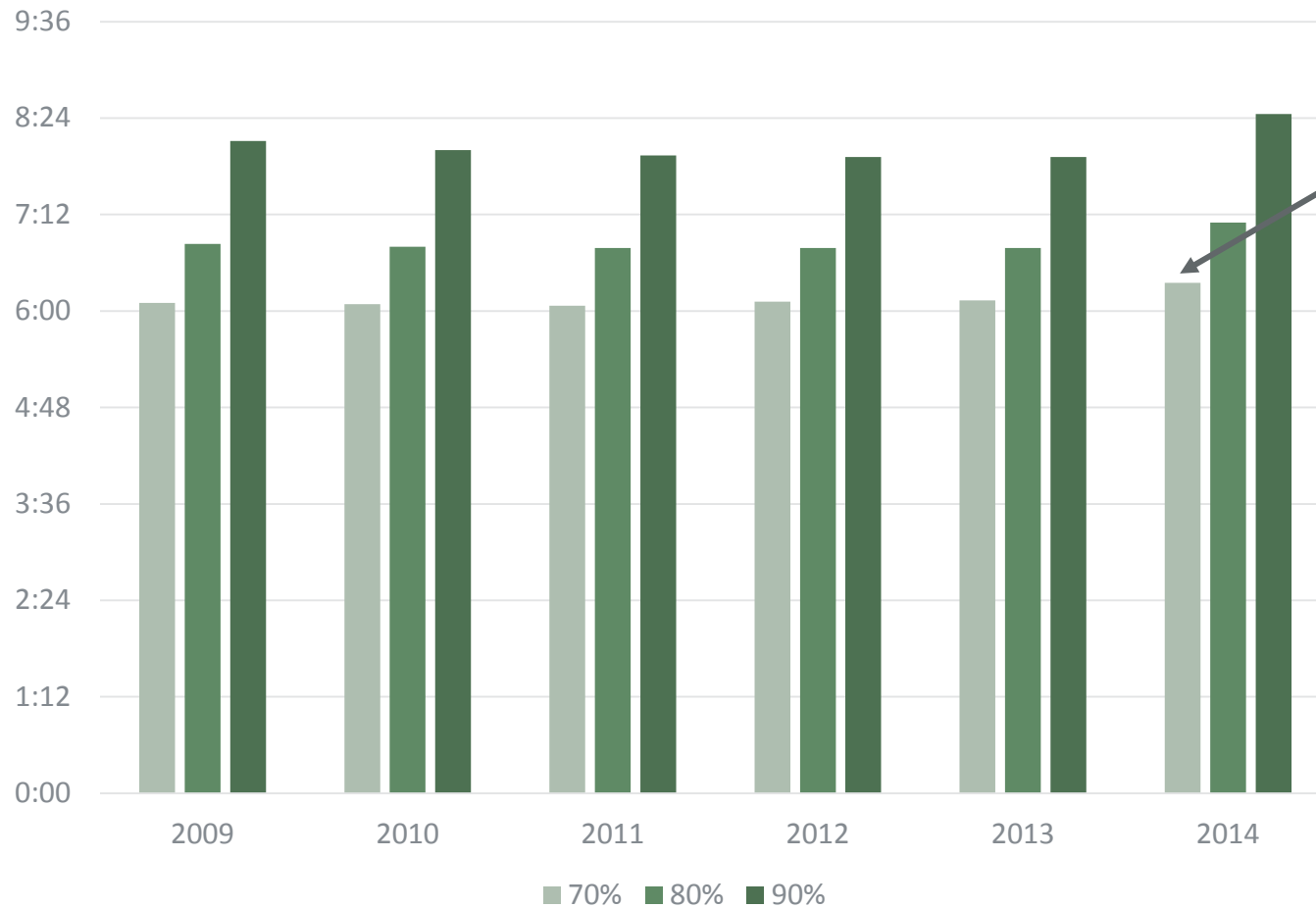
We rely on engines because they are the equipment that allows us to meet our dual role of:

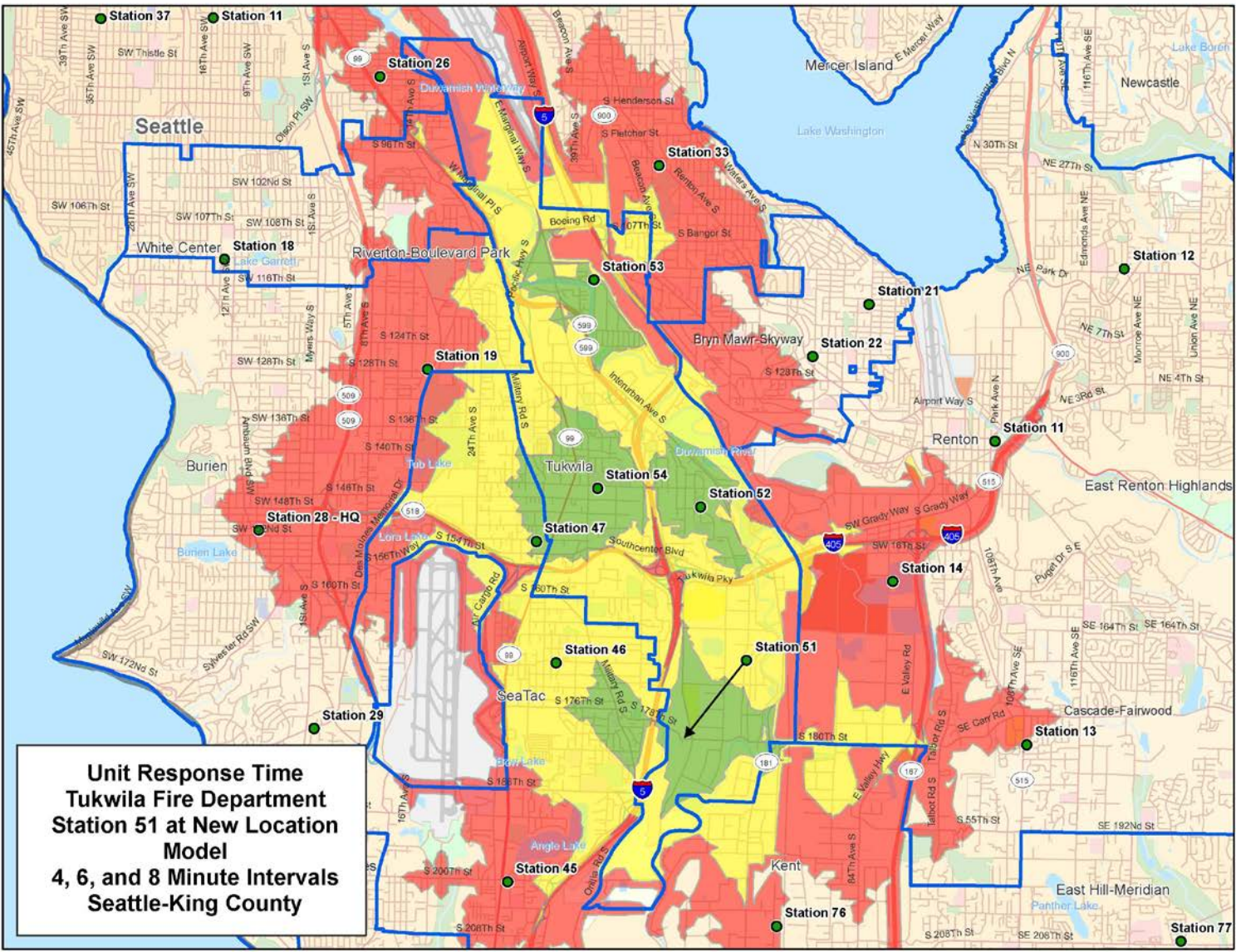

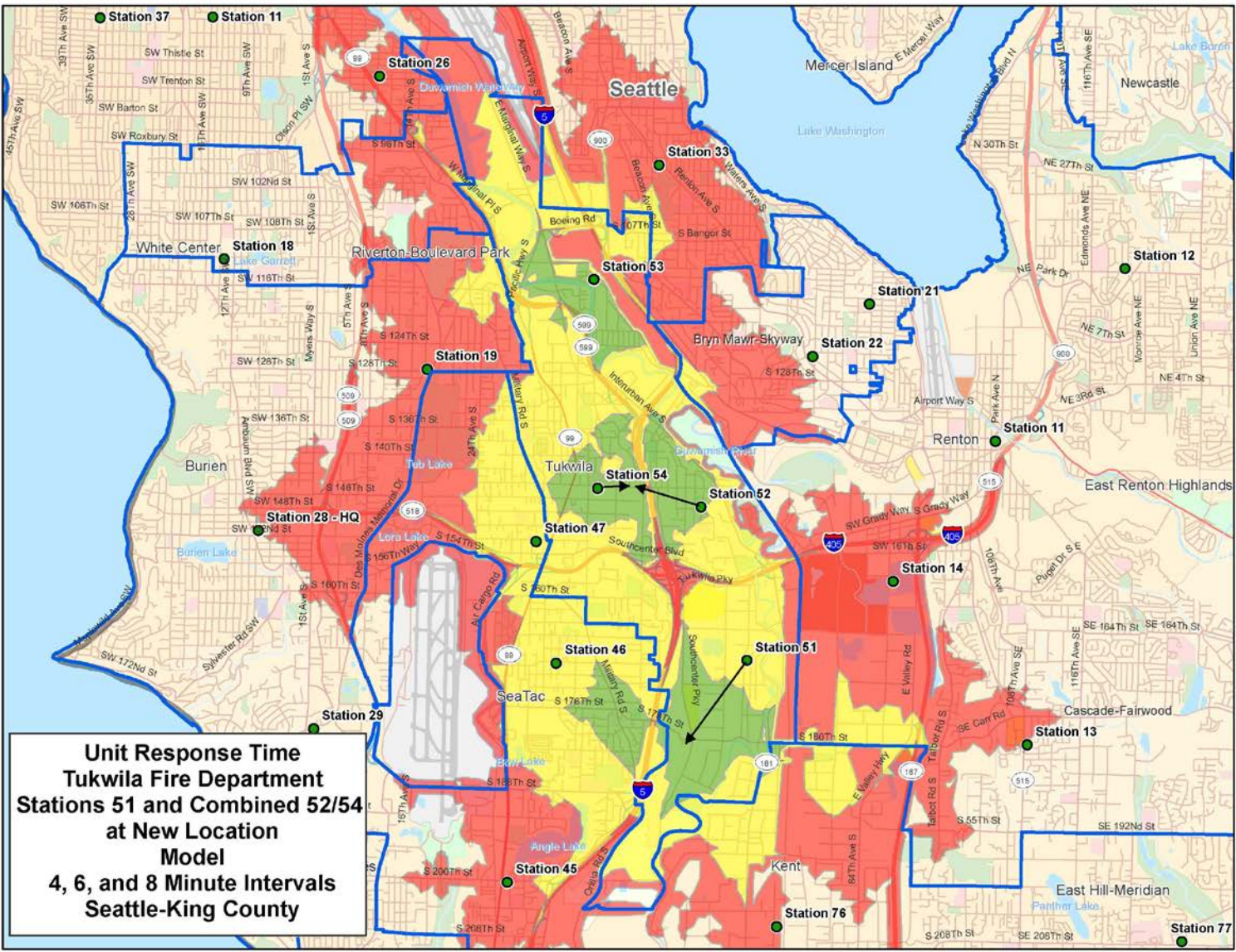

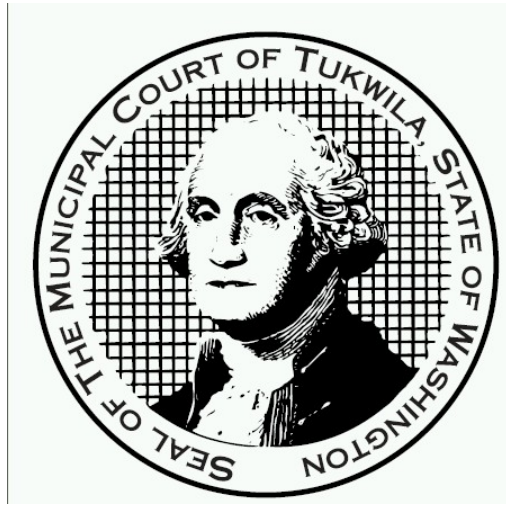
Response time map – station 51 moved

- **Built in 1965**
- **15 staff**
- **Houses:**
 - Fleet
 - Surplus equipment storage
 - Evidence vehicles
 - Locksmith shop
 - Pre-auction vehicle storage

- Subject to NPDES standards
- Deploying 70 cameras throughout the city
- Employing twice as many people
- Providing assistance to first responders
- Servicing 200 vehicles
- Subject to OSHA standards

Impacts to response times



- Separation between mechanics and snow plows and sanders

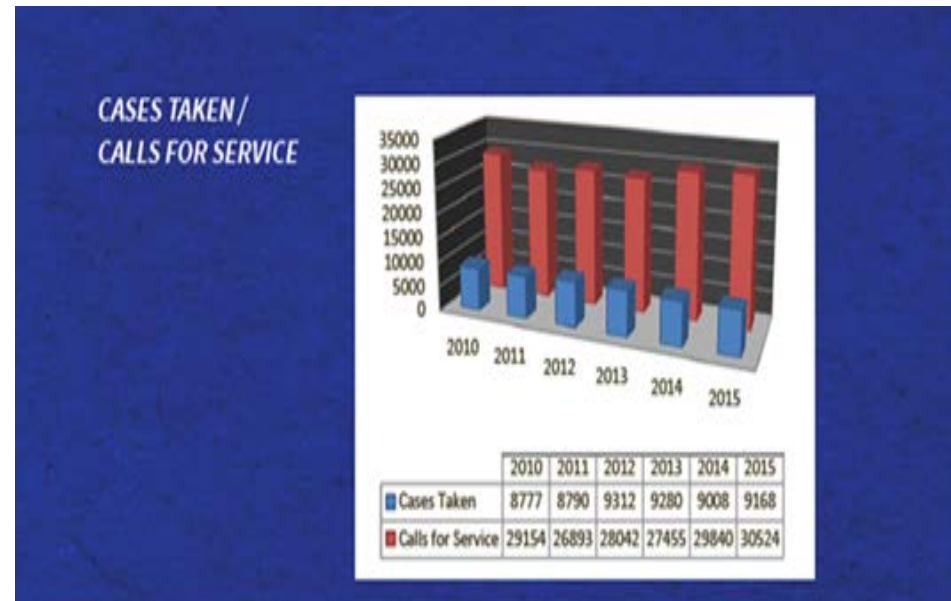

➤ Improved facilities will:

- Address offsite evidence storage issues and re-allocate the evidence technician's time providing better customer service.
- Address the offsite storage of emergency equipment to allow a more efficient response to critical emergencies.

Tukwila Police Department Facilities Impact to Service Levels



➤ Improved facilities will:

- Free-up time to maintain or improve the level of administrative services provided by front office staff.
- Address the front office records regulatory and security requirements

Tukwila Police Department Facilities Impact to Service Levels



- Improved facilities will enable the PD to increase visibility, accessibility, responsiveness and solvability of crimes by:
 - Limiting the overcrowding in the patrol area.
 - Minimizing offsite travel for training due to lack of facilities.
 - Enhancing our electrical capacity to ready the tools of the trade.
 - Ensuring adequate and secure spaces to conduct interrogations.
 - Limiting workforce separation and increasing collaboration.
 - Ensuring timely deployment of officers during emergencies.
